Information for Artists

*** A GreatParks of Hamilton County parking permit is required to enter Sharon Woods. Those without a permit can mention "Heritage Village Paintout" and receive a paid daily permit at no cost. There is No Heritage Village Museum fee during this "Free Days" weekend.

• Artists must agree to, sign and turn in the Artist's Agreement at Check In.

• Artists must bring all their own materials and supplies.

• All works of art must be produced on site. All substrates must be stamped at Check In. 90% of the work must be plein air. All painting & drawing media accepted. No photography.

• Artists may paint anywhere in the Village or near the Village, but all artwork must contain recognizable elements from the Village during this event to be eligible for judging.

• Artists must provide their own easels for displaying artwork and are strongly encouraged to have their works framed for display.

• All works may be **For Sale** or **NFS**. Only artwork produced during the 2-day event may be For Sale. All sales will be between the buyer and individual artists. **No Commission!**

Enter Sharon Woods Park from the Lebanon Road entrance, proceed on Sharon Woods Drive to the Entry Kiosk for Park Permit check, continue straight on Sharon Woods Drive past the Buckeye Falls Drive intersection, continue on Sharon Woods Drive as it loops around the parking lot and Park Ranger building, turn right into the Service Area (IGNORE "Do Not Enter"), following the temporary "Artists Entrance" signs.

A Gear Drop Off Area is provided by the Registration Tent. Please drop off your gear and proceed to park your car in the designated area.

A Designated Parking Area in the grass near the treeline has been set aside for Artists' vehicles.

Come back to the Registration Tent to check in or register for the event. We will be stamping canvases and other substrates prior to their use. A map of the Village will be provided.

The Wet Paint Sales (one on Saturday and one on Sunday) will be in front of the Haynor House on either side of the gravel path.
