## "Bringing a Painting to a Finish"

## **Palette**

**Turpenoid or Gamsol** (no turpentine please) in a larger airtight container.

**Brushes**- This is totally a personal choice. Bring what you have and are comfortable using. I use flats and filberts of all sizes.

**Canvas-** For this two day workshop, you will need two 12x16 canvases and an older completely dry painting of a still life or florals along with its reference photo (can be on an Ipad or printed)

**Sketch Book-** also bring along a soft pencil and kneaded eraser

**Medium-** None needed but if you like using medium bring Gamblin Solvent free Gel. It has no odor and better for a large group.

## **Paint**

Lemon yellow
Cad yellow medium
Indian Yellow
Raw Sienna
Cadmium Orange

Cadmium Red or Permanent Red Alizarin Crimson Permanent Rose Viridian Sap Green Ultramarine Blue Cerulean Blue Ivory Black

Titanium Zinc White Titanium White

Transparent Oxide Brown (Rembrandt)
Transparent Oxide Red (Rembrandt)
(these last two aren't sold locally but you can easily find them online)

Odds and Ends: palette knife, razor blade scraper, vinyl or latex gloves (optional), grocery bags, paper towels, cosmetic triangles, q-tips, view finder, gray scale

I will bring poppy oil for the class to use for "Oiling Out" our old paintings.

Kindly bring still life objects, fruits or flowers to share.
